## "HE OPERATES STANDARD GAUGE TINPLATE

THIS IS A STORY ABOUT AN HERETOFORE UNHEARALDED OPERATING STANDARD GAUGE LAYOUT. UP IN VENTURA COUNTY, WHICH BORDERS THE NORTH OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY, AND OVER ON THE COAST, IS THE NO LONGER "LITTLE" TOWN OF OXNARD. KING OF THE TIN PLATERS IN THIS AREA IS THE PERSONABLE JOHN PARKER WHO LIVES IN AN ATTRACTIVE HOME WITH HIS WIFE PAT AND THEIR TWO-YEAR OLD DAUGHTER.

INGENIOUSLY, JOHN HAS WORKED OUT A UNIQUE OPERATING LAYOUT IN HIS GARAGE. I SAY UNIQUE AS IT IS IN TWO SECTIONS, ONE OF SCRATCH-BUILT WIDE RADIUS TRACK ENCIRCLING A TOWN OF BEAUTIFULLY BUILT SCALE BUILDINGS; THE OTHER OVAL OF TIN PLATE TRACK GROUPS LIONEL AND AMERICAN FLYER STATIONS, TOWERS, STREET LITES, ETC. THESE TWO OVALS ARE CONNECTED WITH SWITCHES AND CROSS OVERS. JOHN RUNS HIS TRAINS ON AC OR DC, BUT THE LATTER IS FAR SUPERIOR, AS IT GIVES HIM SMOOTHER STARTING AND BETTER CONTROL.

BRIDGES ARE A FAVORITE WITH JOHN SO HE HAS A HELLS GATE MODEL AND EVERY OTHER ONE LIONEL PRODUCED, I THINK. ALSO, HE HAS TWO OF THOSE AF WOODEN TRESTLE JOBS WHICH SURE DO ADD TO HIS LAYOUT'S LOOK.

JOHN DISPLAYS HIS COLLECTION ON NICE SHELVES IN THE DEN AND HAS SEVERAL ACCESSORIES, NOT IN USE ON THE LAYOUT, IN A GLASS CASE ON THE GARAGE WALL. YOU REALLY OUGHT TO STOP SOMETIME AT THE PARKER'S AND JOHN WILL GIVE YOU A THRILL AS HE RACES HIS BLUE COMET DOWN THE BACK STRETCH AT BREAK NECK SPEED:

WHAT HAVE YOU FOUND LATELY? WELL THE "OL PRO" SCORED AGAIN: THE ACE OF TRACERS OF OLD TIN PLATE, WES FRYE, CAME UP WITH - YES - A No. 10 TROLLEY IN REAL GOOD SHAPE. ALSO A No. 34 - YOU KNOW, THE SIX WHEEL ELECTRIC TYPE SIMILAR TO THE No. 33. BOTH OF THESE BEAUTIES WERE OF THE "SLIP ON HEAD LITE" VINTAGE. LET US HEAR FROM YOU FELLOWS. WHAT HAVE YOU FOUND LATELY?

BILL HARRIS TOOK ON A REAL LOAD THE LAST PART OF SEPTEMBER. HE READIED ABOUT HALF OF HIS COLLECTION FOR DISPLAY AND CARTED IT OUT TO POMONA. THE LA COUNTY FAIR WAS GRACED BY BILL'S EXTENSIVE COLLEC-TION. HE FILLED HIS 30' BOOTH WITH MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED SETS OF ALL GAUGES. AROUND THE BACK COUNTER, UP EACH SIDE AND ALONG THE ERONT HE LAID LIONEL "O" GAUGE SCALE TRACK AND OPERATED MANY TRAIN COMBINA-TIONS, BOTH OLD AND NEW. THIS AMOUNTED TO ABOUT 75' OF TRACK. BILL WON A GOLD CUP FOR FIRST PLACE FOR HIS DISPLAY. WES FRYE, MET ROBERTS AND HARRISON BEMIS HELPED HIM SET UP AND OPERATE HIS BOOTH. IT BEING A LONG WAY OFF HAD ITS EFFECT ON THE ATTENDANCE. WITH SO FEW THERE, AT LEAST THE WRITER HAD
HIS FILL OF WONDERFUL HOME-MADE COOKIES.


MIDDLETON, PLEASE BRING YOUR MAP, COMPASS, TOY TRAIN DIRECTORY AND A NAVIGATOR AS WE WANT TO SEE YOU BEFORE 9:30 ON THIS EVENING.

HERE IS A HELPFUL HINT FROM JIM KURTEN WHO HAS ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL COLLECTIONS OF LATE LIONEL STANDARD GAUGE ON THE WEST COAST. INCIDENTALLY, WE ALL CERTAINLY ADMIRE JIM'S BEAUTIFUL NATURAL WOOD CASES AND THE GLASS SLIDING DOORS WHICH KEEP HIS ALMOST MINT COLLECTION FROM GETTING DUSTY.

(OVER)

WHEN JIM ACQUIRES A NEW PIECE WHICH IS DULLED BY DIRT HE FIRST REMOVES THAT TRIM WHICH IS EASILY DONE AND THE TRUCKS. THEN HE USES A RAG SOAKED IN WHITE GASOLINE TO CAREFULLY REMOVE ANY OILY OR GREASY-TYPE DIRT AND STAINS. A WATER SOAKED RAG COMES NEXT FOR THE OTHER TYPES OF DIRT. HE NEXT USES A DRY SOFT CLOTH TO GENTLY. BUT FIRMLY. POLISH OVER AND OVER THE PAINTED SURFACE TO BRING BACK THE ORIGINAL SHEEN. AS A RESULT. THE PAINT NOW LOOKS NEW AND ORIGINAL. THIS EVEN MAKES TRAINS WITH SCRATCHES AND SCUFFED MARKS LOOK REAL FINE. IF THE TRIM IS BRASS IT IS PLACED IN LACOUER THINNER TO REMOVE THE OLD LACQUER. THEN IT IS CAREFULLY, PIECE BY PIECE, IMMERSED IN NITRIC ACID UNTIL CLEAN, RINSED THOROUGHLY IN WATER, AND RUBBED WITH FINE STEEL WOOL. THESE BRIGHTENED PARTS ARE RE-LACQUERED BY DIPPING, BRUSHING OR SPRAYING. NICKEL TRIM IS CAREFULLY CLEANED WITH THE FINE STEEL WOOL AND RUBBED BRISKLY WITH A SOFT CLOTH.

AFTER CAREFUL RE-ASSEMBLY, SHOULD YOU FOLLOW THIS PROCEDURE, YOU WILL HAVE AN ITEM WHICH WALL FAR SUR-PASS, IN APPEARANCE, THE TRAIN YOU STARTED WITH.
