

### Collecting LIONEL Hudsons Through the Years, Part 2

by the end of the 1980s, Lionel had produced three semi-scale Hudsons based on the post-war 773. The 783, 784, & 785 were nice looking locomotives, but collectors kept wondering if a remake of the pre-war 700E was coming?

The announcement came that 1990 would be the year that a new *full-scale* Hudson would be made, including a new 700T scale tender. It was an absolutely a beautiful locomotive, with a cab number of 5340.

Many thought that with this latest 700E, the end of new Hudsons had arrived. After all, what could Lionel make that was better than a 700E? It took seven years for collectors to find out, as a full scale Hudson with the cab number 5344 appeared in the 1997 catalog as the 763E.

It came with a brand-new Vanderbilt steel tender

reminiscent of the prewar Hudson, but Lionel also offered the magnificent centipede tender that New York Central equipped some of the later Hudsons with. I think this combo

makes the 763E a better locomotive than the 700E!

Also in 1997, Lionel did not forget about the lessdetailed 773-style locomotive. Another Hudson was released heading the Santa Fe War Horse freight set. The locomotive number 3447 appears on the tender, while the engine cab sports A.T.&S.F. This is the only scale size Hudson that isn't labeled for the New York Central!

As the end of the decade approached, everyone looked forward to the start of the 21st Century. Coincidentally, Lionel would be completing 100+ years of making toy trains. To celebrate this milestone, the Century Club was born, offering five newly-produced classic postwar-style locomotives, culminating in the first Modern-Era Hudson that was actually numbered 773!

Next time, in Part 3. we'll discover not one, not two, but three Lionel Hudsons numbered 773! Also, there may be a surprise in store!
