


TCA Member Roy Bell Remembrance: 1936 - 2026

Leroy "Roy" Gordon Bell Jr. was born October 13, 1936 and passed away on January 18, 2026 at the age of 89. He was TCA #76-9611, joining our organization some 50 years ago. He also was TTOS #575 and was formerly President of TTOS Southwestern Division.

For TCA Western, Roy was on the board of directors in 1997, 1998 and 2000. In 1999, he served as Vice President of the Division.

Roy also supported the **TTOS Southwestern Limited** newsletter for years with an ad for his State Farm Insurance Branch. Many of our fellow club members were underwritten by the Roy Bell Insurance Agency.

Fifteen years ago, Roy wrote a tribute to his late friend, Jerry Blaine, an avid toy train collector. That remembrance provides a window into what it was like to collect trains in the earlier years of the club, and it makes some interesting reading today. To hear Roy tell the tale, it was a very magical time traveling to York, PA, hunting trains. (This was in the pre-eBay days.) A celebration of Roy Bell's life was held on February 7, 2026 at the home of Janitta Keck. After Gary Keck (founder of **The Train Shack**) passed away, Roy and Janitta discovered each other some 13 years ago and became inseparable. In fact, after the pandemic began, Roy was invited to move to Janitta's Simi Valley home. During the last few months of his life, Janitta cared for Roy, as he fought heart and kidney failure, along with related infections.

TCA Western Division's Board of Directors recently voted to buy a Legacy Brick for Roy at the TCA National Toy Train Museum in Strasburg, PA. It is scheduled to be installed near the museum's entrance before October, 2026.
