All TCA Members and their families are welcome to attend the meet. Come join in the fun and camaraderie of train collecting and operation! The meet will include trading tables, the display theme of rare & collectible Patriotic Trains & Convention Cars, model trains running on operating layouts in multiple gauges, a raffle and potentially an auction, if there is a desire.

The meeting hall doors open at 9 am for setup while the meet officially begins at 10:00 am, typically ends around 2 pm. Parking is free. **The meet also features a repair clinic and refreshments are available.** So bring your sick trains for a checkup, and bring your appetite too!

TCA members are admitted free (**please wear your current membership badge and show it at the door when you enter the hall**). Non-members/train enthusiasts are welcome to attend one (1) Western Division train meet per year for free. We encourage those interested to join the Train Collectors Association after that.

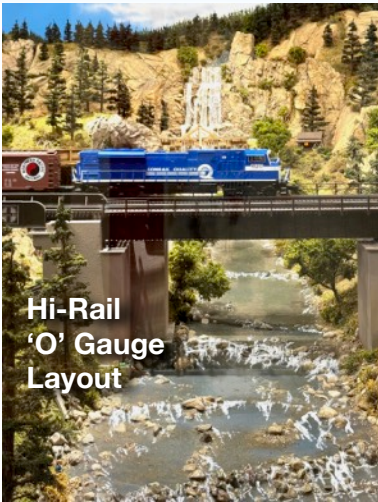

Inside was a beautifully displayed collection of Lionel "O" gauge trains, on two floors, primarily from the 1930s - 1940s (with a few choice outliers). **If you missed it, you must go!** Next month, it's open on August 10th & 31st from 10am to 1pm; admission for seniors (over 65) is \$8.00. 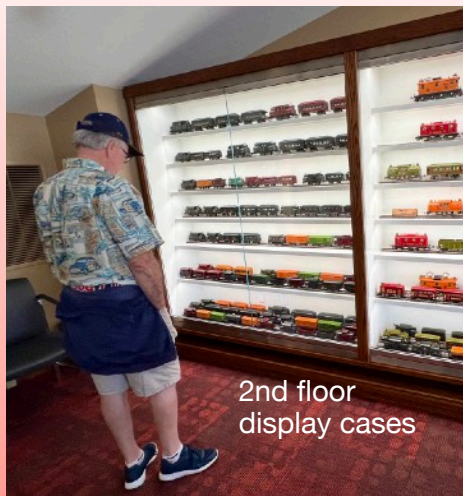

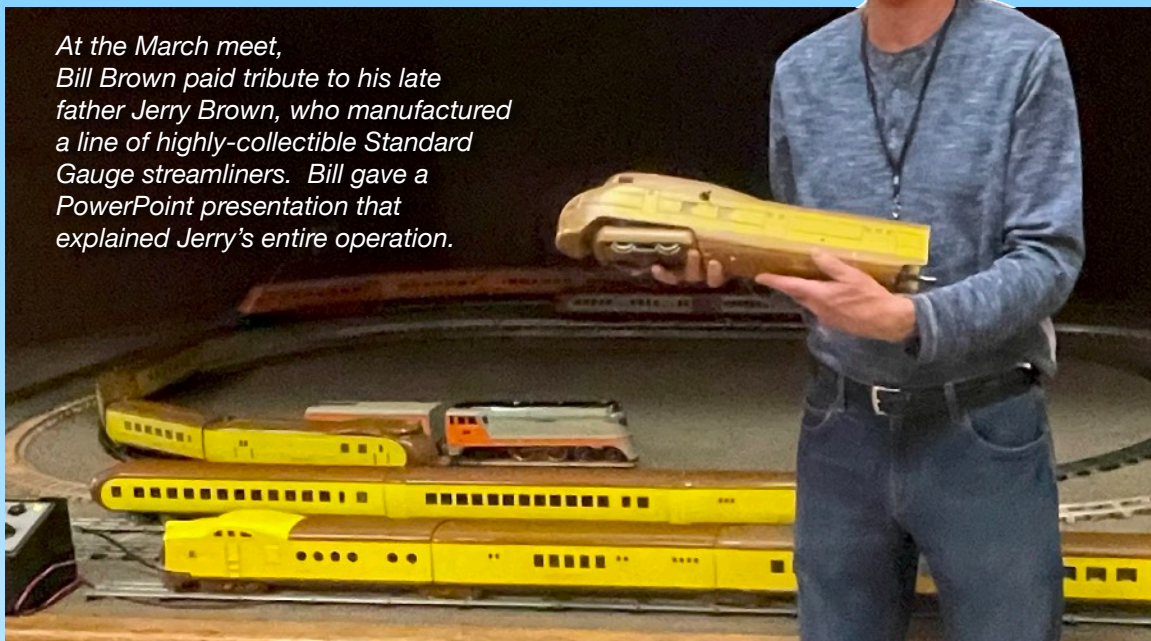

TCA National's 70th Anniversary Convention

This year, TCA Western Division President Jon Lang paid me the distinct honor of appointing me as an Alternate to represent Western Division at the TCA National Convention in Lancaster, PA, as our organization celebrates its 70th Anniversary.

I flew into Harrisburg International Airport on Tuesday, June 18, 2024. When the train arrived at the restored Pennsylvania Station in Lancaster, PA, I learned that the Marriott was only about 1.2 miles southward, so I strolled down to the hotel, as dusk fell (see photo, left).



The next morning, I attended the first of three TCA National Board Meetings. This one started at 7am EDT (that's 4am PDT). After a cup of coffee, I was ready to go! On the next day, Western Division made Motion #24-15. We moved to close the board meeting in honor of the late Western Division member and TCA National Past President, Wayne Sheriff. The motion passed unanimously.

The 70th Anniversary Nat'l Convention was put on jointly by Eastern Division & Keystone Division. The 2-day Toy Train Marketplace, which adjoined the hotel at the Lancaster Convention Center, was a hotbed of buying & selling.



The tours were great, but I managed to do only a few of them. I saw the PRR Museum, the Strasburg Railroad and the Choo-Choo Barn. No trip to the Strasburg area would have been complete without visiting the National Toy Train Museum, in Paradise, PA. *It was beautiful!*
